

I-30 Construction Update

Upcoming work scheduled:

Thursday, May 16, 8 PM until 6 AM, Contractor crews will be working at the eastbound I-30 to southbound I-369/US 59 interchange. This work will require closing eastbound I-30 Exit 220A (I-369/US 59) and the outside lane of I-30 eastbound. Motorists needing to access I-369/US 59 south will use Exit 219 and travel the frontage road. This work is expected to be completed in one night. Inclement weather or other unforeseen issues could cause delays or changes in the work schedule.

Beginning Friday, May 17, the eastbound entrance ramp between Summerhill Road/FM 1397 and Stateline Avenue/US 71 will be closed. Motorists needing to access eastbound I-30 will travel the frontage road to State Line Ave., through the traffic signal and then enter the eastbound I-30 travel lanes between State Line Ave. and Jefferson Ave. This work is expected to take 2 weeks. Inclement weather or other unforeseen issues could cause delays or changes in the work schedule.

Continuing work:

Work continues at eastbound I-30 Exit 223 (US 71/US 59/State Line Ave.) and along the frontage road. Motorists needing to access US 71/US 59/State Line will use Exit 222 and travel the frontage road.

Motorists are encouraged to watch for traffic control signs and leave time for delays in daily commutes.

TxDOT reminds local commuters that the I-30 Frontage Road system allows traffic to travel eastbound from FM 989/Kings Highway to US 71/Stateline and westbound from US 71/Stateline to FM 989/Kings Highway, continuously, without ever stopping at a traffic signal.
