
ALL Comments must be received by or postmarked by December 2, 2022, to be include in the revision.

The Public Review and Comment Period is for the following MPO documents:

- ✓ FY2022-2023 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) Amendment Four. The UPWP specifies the planning priorities, activities, and tasks which the MPO will address during the two-year period. This amendment is to update the funding amounts for the various tasks.
- ✓ FY2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Arkansas portion. The TIP contains projects selected and programmed with federal, state and/or local funding and is consistent with the Region's Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP).
- ✓ FY2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) Amendment One Texas portion. The MPO is removing the following two (2) projects which Let in FY2022. The projects are:
 - o #46A FM 989 (Kings Highway) widen existing 2-lane highway to 4-lane divided high
 - o #55 IH 30 Frontage Road Construct one-way frontage roads entrance and exit rams and turnarounds.
